#### **General description** 1.

The 74AHC1G17 and 74AHCT1G17 are single buffers with Schmitt-trigger inputs. Inputs are overvoltage tolerant. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed voltage environments.

The AHC device has CMOS input switching levels and supply voltage range 2 V to 5.5 V.

The AHCT device has TTL input switching levels and supply voltage range 4.5 V to 5.5 V.




Fig 6. Test circuit for measuring switching times




Fig 9. Typical 74AHC1G17 transfer characteristics;  $V_{CC} = 3.0 \text{ V}$ 




Fig 10. Typical 74AHC1G17 transfer characteristics;  $V_{CC} = 4.5 \text{ V}$ 





Fig 11. Typical 74AHC1G17 transfer characteristics; V<sub>CC</sub> = 5.5 V








Fig 13. Typical 74AHCT1G17 transfer characteristics;  $V_{CC} = 5.5 \text{ V}$ 

# 14. Application information

The slow input rise and fall times cause additional power dissipation, which can be calculated using the following formula:

 $P_{add} = f_i \times (t_r \times \Delta I_{CC(AV)} + t_f \times \Delta I_{CC(AV)}) \times V_{CC}$  where:

 $P_{add}$  = additional power dissipation ( $\mu W$ );

 $f_i = input frequency (MHz);$ 

 $t_r$  = input rise time (ns); 10 % to 90 %;

 $t_f$  = input fall time (ns); 90 % to 10 %;

 $\Delta I_{CC(AV)}$  = average additional supply current ( $\mu A$ ).




Fig 14. Average additional  $I_{CC}$  for 74AHC1G17 Schmitt trigger devices; linear change of  $V_I$  between  $0.1V_{CC}$  to  $0.9V_{CC}$ 





Fig 15. Average additional  $I_{CC}$  for 74AHCT1G17 Schmitt trigger devices; linear change of  $V_{I}$  between 0.1 $V_{CC}$  to 0.9 $V_{CC}$

Average additional  $I_{CC}$  differs with positive or negative input transitions, as shown in Figure 14 and Figure 15.




Fig 17. Package outline SOT753 (SC-74A)
