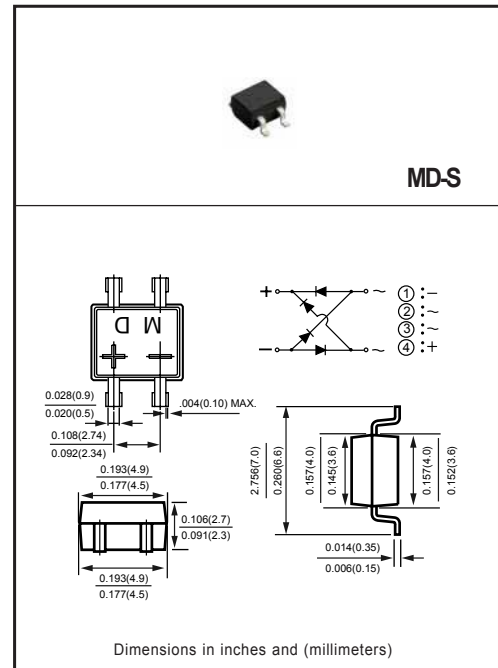

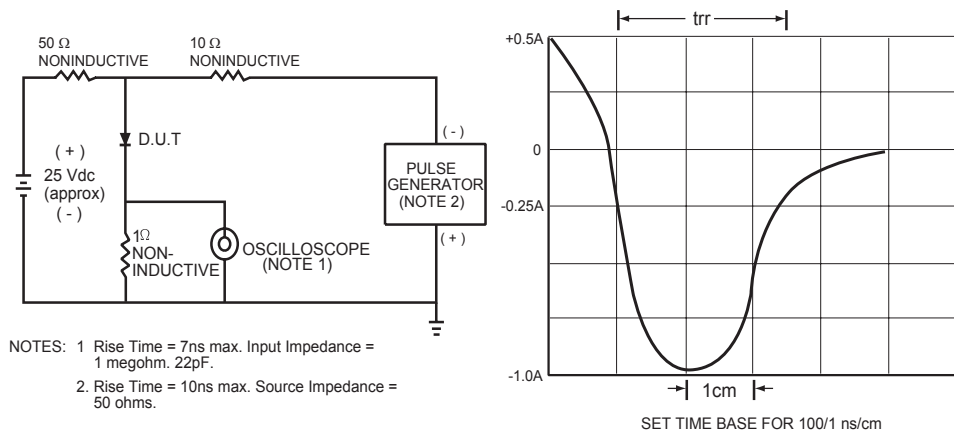


FIG.1 TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC

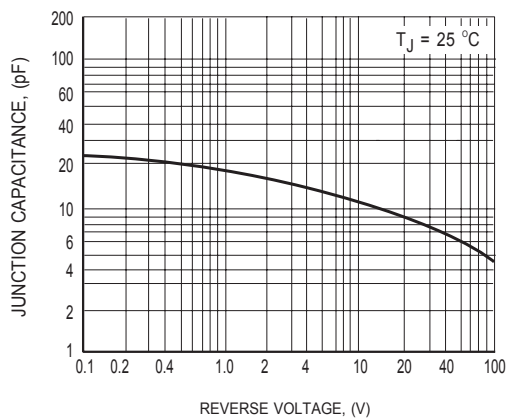


FIG.2 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

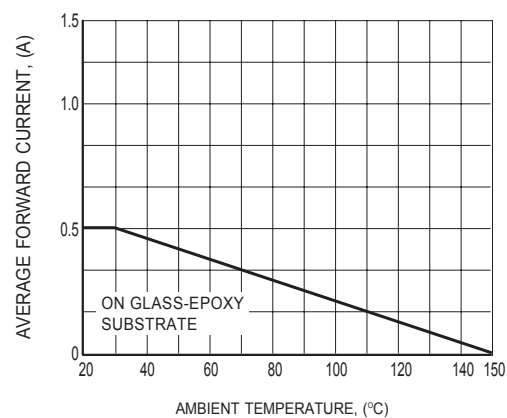


FIG.3 TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

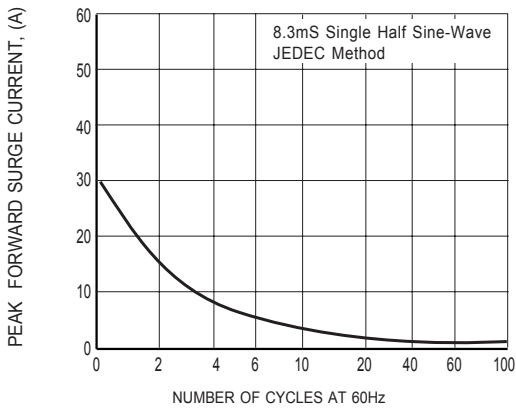


FIG. 4 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

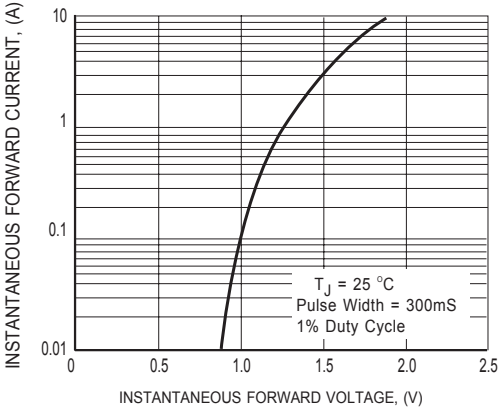


FIG.5 TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

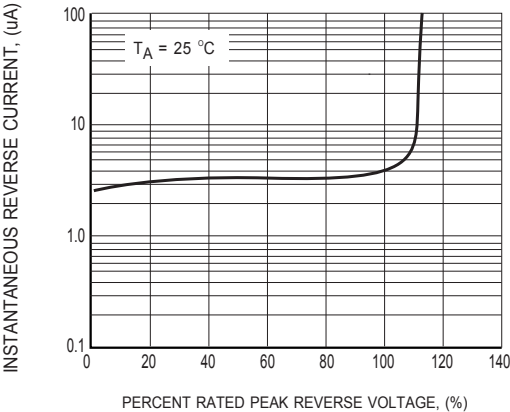
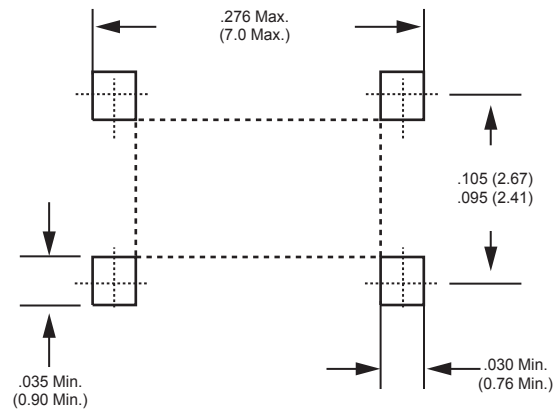


FIG.6 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
